## **PRIVACY NOTICE – GDPR**

### **What we collect**

Lonsdale Health Products Limited will be what's known as the 'controller' of the personal data you provide to us. Our company registration number is 01743273 and our registered address is Unit 6, Ingleton Industrial Estate, New Road Ingleton Via Carnforth, Lancashire, LA6 3NU.

We collect personal data about you, including for example the individual's name, address, and email]. This may also include any special types of information or location based information.

### **Why we need it**

We take your privacy seriously and will use your personal information in a number of ways which will help us including as an example job application, initial contact.

The legal basis for this processing is :-

- The individual has given consent to the processing .
- The processing is necessary for the performance of a contract with the individual or necessary in order to take steps prior to entering a contract with the individual.
- The processing is necessary for compliance with a legal obligation on Lonsdale.
- The processing is necessary to protect the vital interests of the individual or another natural person.
- The processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest.
- The processing is necessary for the purposes of the legitimate interests of Lonsdale, except where the interests are overridden by the rights and freedoms of the individual. If using this legal basis, you should specify what the legitimate interests are.]

[If you fail to provide certain information when requested, we may not be able to perform the contract we have entered into with you (such as paying you or providing a benefit), or we may be prevented from complying with our legal obligations (such as to ensure the health and safety of our workers).]

### **How we will use the information about you?**

We may share your information with credit reference companies, banks and IT companies.

### **How long we keep it**

We will keep your basic personal data for three years after which time it will be destroyed.

### **What are your rights?**

Under certain circumstances, by law you have the right to:

- request access to, correction or erasure of, the personal information we hold about you;
- request the restriction of processing of your personal information;
- object to processing of your personal information where we are relying on a legitimate interest and there is something about your particular situation which makes you want to object to processing on this ground; and
- request the transfer of your personal information to another party.

If you want to review, verify, correct or request erasure of your personal information, object to the processing of your personal information, or request that we transfer a copy of your personal information to another party, please contact the Managing Director in writing at the address above

You will not have to pay a fee to access your personal information or to exercise any of the other rights. However, we may charge a reasonable fee if your request for access is clearly unfounded or excessive. Alternatively, we may refuse to comply with the request in such circumstances.

We may need to request specific information from you to help us confirm your identity and ensure your right to access the information (or to exercise any of your other rights). This is another appropriate security measure to ensure that personal information is not disclosed to any person who has no right to receive it.

Where relevant, you have the right to withdraw consent at any time and this means that we cannot process your data provided without your consent.
